Florida Not All Aboard to Hold Forum for Republican Congressional Candidates

Stuart, Florida – Florida Not All Aboard has announced its first candidate forum for contenders for the Republican nomination in Florida's 18th Congressional District.

The forum will be held from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM on Friday, June 27th, 2014 in the Anderson Community Room at the Robert Morgade Library, located at 5851 SE Community Drive, in Stuart, Florida. The candidate forum is free and open to all members of the public and media, subject to seating availability.

The forum will be moderated by K. C. Traylor of Florida Not All Aboard. Candidates will be given the opportunity to make a brief opening statement, followed by several rounds of issue-specific questions selected by Florida Not All Aboard, with each question being presented to each candidate for a brief response. The floor will then be opened to questions for the candidates from community members in attendance, followed by a brief closing statement from each candidate.

The forum is structured as a constructive discussion panel requiring detailed, issue-specific responses from each candidate on issues relevant to the proposed All Aboard Florida train project. While candidates may compare and contrast their positions, each is expected to remain civil, factual, and issue-focused.

Traylor spoke of the need for clarity from candidates, stating, "Few issues will have a greater impact than All Aboard Florida on our quality of life along the Treasure Coast. Florida's voters deserve crystal clear answers from this crowded primary field regarding each candidate's respective stance on Fortress Investment Group's plan to clog our roads, disrupt our small businesses, and devastate our marine industry. Florida Not All Aboard will be holding each candidate accountable by putting them on the record."

Emphasizing the non-partisan nature of this issue, Traylor continued, "We will invite the eventual Republican nominee along with incumbent US Representative Patrick Murphy to a more detailed one-on-one discussion, once the Republican nominating contest has concluded. It is our aim to provide voters with an accurate comparison of the candidates on this most important of issues."
