



You can see where the Jupiter Medical Center is located. From the intersection of Center Street at Alt. A1A to the Intersection of Fredrick Small Road at Alt. A1A the distance Is 3.0 miles. If a freight train would be 2.6 miles long, it is conceivable that ALL 3 intersections can be blocked at the same time. Therefore blocking passage to the hospital without a lengthy Trip to the next intersection south of Fredrick Small Rd.

OTHER NOTES:

- Indiantown Rd does not allow passage north/south on Old Dixie Highway nor on Toney Penna, due to a medians. Toney Penna has a peanut median that defers southern traffic on Old Dixie to west bound Toney Penna.
- It takes only one or two intersections blocked to affect traffic to the hospital. This affects all of Tequesta and all Jupiter residents East and South East of the tracks.
- THE TRAIN CROSSING ALSO LEAD TO MAJOR EVACUATION ROUTES
